DISTRIBUTION ORDER

(Schedule II to the Order of November 16, 2020)

- [1] **ON READING** the *Petitioners' Motion* (i) for an Order extending the Stay Period, (ii) to Amend the Re-Amended and Restated Initial Order and (iii) for the Issuance of a Distribution Order (the "**Motion**"), the affidavit and the exhibits in support thereof, as well as the report of the Monitor dated November 11, 2020 (the "**Report**");
- [2] **SEEING** the service of the Motion;
- [3] **SEEING** the submissions of the CCAA Parties, the Monitor and their respective attorneys;
- [4] **GIVEN** that on May 15, 2020, the Court issued a *Re-Amended and Restated Initial Order* (the "**Re-Amended and Restated Initial Order**") empowering the Monitor to take all necessary or desirable steps to recover any and all potential unpaid customs duties incurred by the Petitioners (the "**Duties**"), pursuant to Section 28.1(a) of the Re-Amended and Restated Initial Order
- [5] **GIVEN** that on November 16, 2020, a Re-Re-Amended and Restated Initial Order was issued and provides for identical Monitor's powers regarding the Duties;
- [6] **GIVEN** that the Monitor has collected an amount of over \$909,000.00 of Duties in accordance with the Re-Amended and Restated Initial Order and may further collect additional Duties (the "**Proceeds**");

WHEREFORE THE COURT:

- [7] **GRANTS** the Motion.

SERVICE AND DEFINITIONS

- [8] **ORDERS** that any prior delay for the presentation of this Motion is hereby abridged and validated so that this Motion is properly returnable today and hereby dispenses with further service thereof.
- [9] **PERMITS** service of this Order at any time and place and by any means whatsoever.

- [10] **ORDERS** that any capitalized term used and not defined herein shall have the meaning ascribed thereto in the initial order of this Court dated December 2, 2019, as amended and restated (the "Initial Order").

DISTRIBUTION OF PROCEEDS

- [11] **ORDERS** that the Monitor be and is hereby authorized and directed to distribute, without any further Order of the Court, all such net amounts of the Proceeds held by the Monitor with respect to the Duties collected and to be collected (the "Payments") in a manner substantially described in paragraph 44 of the Report of the Monitor (November 11, 2020);
- [12] **ORDERS** that notwithstanding:
- (i) the pendency of these proceedings;
 - (ii) any petition for a receiving or bankruptcy order now or hereafter issued pursuant to the *Bankruptcy and Insolvency Act* ("BIA") and any order issued pursuant to any such petition; or
 - (iii) the provisions of any federal or provincial legislation;

the Payments shall be binding on any trustee in bankruptcy, interim receiver or receiver that may be appointed in respect of the Petitioners, and shall not be void or voidable nor deemed to be a preference, assignment, fraudulent conveyance, transfer at undervalue or other reviewable transaction under the BIA, article 1631 and following of the *Civil Code of Québec* or any other applicable federal or provincial legislation, as against the Vendor, the Purchaser or the Monitor, and shall not constitute conduct meriting an oppression remedy under any applicable statute.

LIMITATION OF LIABILITY

- [13] **DECLARES** that, subject to other orders of this Court, nothing herein contained shall require the Monitor to take control, or to otherwise manage all or any part of the Proceeds. The Monitor shall not, as a result of this Order, be deemed to be in possession of any of the Proceeds within the meaning of environmental legislation, the whole pursuant to the terms of the *Companies' Creditors Arrangement Act*.
- [14] **DECLARES** that the Payments made by the Monitor pursuant to this Order are not made by the Monitor in its personal or corporate capacity or as legal representative of the Petitioners, including the Vendor, and that the Monitor, in carrying out its role under this Order, shall have all the protections given to it by the CCAA and the Initial Order or as an officer of the Court, and shall incur no corporate or personal liability or obligation as a result of the carrying out of its obligations under this Order, and for greater certainty, further **ORDERS AND**

DECLARES that the Monitor shall not, under any circumstances, be liable for any of the tax liabilities of the Petitioners regardless of how or when such liability may have arisen, and is released from any obligations or liability in connection with any tax liabilities owing by the Petitioners, including the Vendor, or any withholdings or deductions that any person or party may assert should or should not have been paid or made in connection with such Payments;

- [15] **DECLARES** that no action lies against the Monitor by reason of this Order or the performance of any act authorized by this Order, except by leave of the Court. The entities related to the Monitor or belonging to the same group as the Monitor shall benefit from the protection arising under the present paragraph.

GENERAL

- [16] **DECLARES** that this Order shall have full force and effect in all provinces and territories in Canada;
- [17] **DECLARES** that the Vendor and the Monitor shall be authorized to apply as it may consider necessary or desirable, with or without notice, to any other court or administrative body, whether in Canada, the United States of America or elsewhere, for orders which aid and complement the Order and, without limitation to the foregoing, an order under Chapter 15 of the U.S. Bankruptcy Code, for which the Monitor shall be the foreign representative. All courts and administrative bodies of all such jurisdictions are hereby respectfully requested to make such orders and to provide such assistance to the Monitor as may be deemed necessary or appropriate for that purpose;
- [18] **REQUESTS** the aid and recognition of any court or administrative body in any Province of Canada and any Canadian federal court or administrative body and any federal or state court or administrative body in the United States of America and any court or administrative body elsewhere, to act in aid of and to be complementary to this Court in carrying out the terms of the Order;
- [19] **ORDERS** the provisional execution of the present Order notwithstanding any appeal and without the requirement to provide any security or provision for costs whatsoever;
