GIVEN the provisions of the CCAA;

THE COURT:

[1] **GRANTS** the Application;

[2] **DECLARES** that the notices given of presentation of the Application are adequate and sufficient;

Definitions

[3] **DECLARES** that, unless otherwise indicated, capitalized terms found herein shall have the same meaning ascribed thereto in the Plan;

Extension of the Stay

[4] **ORDERS** that the Stay Period, as defined in the Initial Order, is hereby extended until July 30, 2021;

Creditors' Meeting

- [5] **ORDERS** that, subject to any further order that may be rendered by the Court, the Creditors' Meeting shall be held by videoconference or telephone conference on or before July 23, 2021 (the "**Meeting Date**");
- [6] **ORDERS** that, save for the Stay Period and the Meeting Date, all other orders contained in the Meeting Order shall continue to have full force and effect;
- [7] **ORDERS** that the Monitor may apply to this Court for advice and directions in connection with the discharge or variation of its powers and duties under this Order;

[8]	ORDERS the provisional execution of this Order notwithstanding appeal;	
[9]	THE WHOLE without costs.
