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The Biden Administration released its Spring Regulatory Agenda.

HHS announced: (1) <u>additional flexibilities</u> to <u>prevent coverage lapses</u> during Medicaid/CHIP renewals; (2) a <u>\$15M pediatric workforce loan</u> <u>forgiveness</u> program; and, (3) expansion of the Extra Help program to <u>decrease prescription drug costs for low-income Medicare beneficiaries</u> and those with disabilities.

FDA advisory committees unanimously recommended: (1) <u>full approval</u> of Biogen-Eisai's Alzheimer's drug, Leqembi; and, (2) a <u>monovalent COVID-19 vaccine booster this fall/winter</u> that targets an XBB variant.



Healthcare law and policy news

CMS Office of the Actuary <u>projects national health expenditures</u> (NHE) will reach \$7.2T (19.6% of GDP) by 2031; Medicare spending will grow 7.5% annually, on average, from 2022-2031, compared to 5.4% for total NHE.

MedPAC's <u>June Report to Congress</u> includes <u>recommendations</u> to reduce Medicare Part B prescription drug spending, align payments across ambulatory settings, and reform the wage index... and a <u>Congressionallymandated report on telehealth</u> use during the PHE.

Chamber of Commerce <u>sued</u> to <u>block implementation</u> of the Medicare Drug Price Negotiation Program... Following <u>an agreement from the parties</u>, a federal appeals court <u>maintained its stay of a district court's order</u> striking down mandated coverage of preventive services... Allergan, Teva, CVS, and Walgreens <u>agreed to additional settlements</u> (\$18.75B) with state/local governments over opioid epidemic-related claims.

Novartis <u>will acquire Chinook Therapeutics</u> (\$3.5B)... Walgreens <u>sold its</u> remaining stake (\$330M) in Option Care Health and is <u>partnering with</u> <u>Freenome on clinical trials</u> for early cancer detection... Astra Zeneca <u>will</u> <u>collaborate with Quell Therapeutics (up to \$2B)</u> on autoimmune disease cell therapies... Uber Health <u>launched grocery and over-the-counter</u> <u>medication delivery</u> services.

A USC analysis <u>estimated overpayments to Medicare Advantage plans</u> <u>exceed \$75B/year</u> due to <u>favorable beneficiary selection</u> and coding intensity... A KFF <u>survey found</u> 81% of insured adults rate their insurance "excellent" or "good," but 58% have experienced problems using their coverage... More than 300 non-profit hospitals <u>reported 7.5% year-over-year revenue growth in May</u>, up significantly from April (3.5%).

AMA adopted policies, <u>among others</u>, advocating for: (1) <u>overhauling</u> <u>Medicare physician payment</u>; (2) <u>increasing study/oversight and patient</u> <u>education</u> of AI; and, (3) <u>deemphasizing use of BMI</u> in assessing health/obesity.

House Education and Workforce Committee <u>advanced legislation to offer</u> telehealth services as a tax-free benefit separate from other health plans.

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
