## Healthcare regulatory news

FDA granted accelerated approval to Sarepta Therapeutics' <u>Duchenne</u> <u>muscular dystrophy gene therapy</u> for children aged 4 through 5... FDA <u>announced a pilot program</u> to reduce risks associated with using <u>in vitro diagnostics to select appropriate oncology</u> drugs for patients... FDA <u>approved a new drug class</u> to treat pediatric type 2 diabetes alongside diet and exercise.

CMS <u>proposed</u> a <u>Transitional Coverage for Emerging Technologies</u> pathway for breakthrough devices... CMS <u>released additional details about patient registries for coverage</u> of FDA-approved amyloid-targeting Alzheimer's drugs.

A CDC advisory committee: (1) voted to <u>allow RSV vaccination</u> of patients aged 60-64 (13-0) and patients aged 65+ (9-5) based on shared decision-

making with their doctor; and, (2) discussed an RSV vaccine (administered to pregnant individuals) and antibody to protect infants.

SAMHSA <u>released an advisory</u> on identifying/managing long COVID mental health symptoms/conditions.

FTC brought an <u>enforcement action</u> against 1health.io for exposing sensitive user genetic data and unfairly changing its privacy policy.

USPSTF recommended all adults 64 or vounger be screened for anxiety.

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#### Healthcare law and policy news

President Biden will appoint Mandy Cohen as Director of the CDC.

PhRMA, National Infusion Center Association, and Global Colon Cancer Association <u>sued</u> to stop <u>implementation</u> of the Medicare Drug Price Negotiation Program... Bristol Myers Squibb filed a separate suit.

HHS <u>asked a federal judge to overturn</u> a decision finding Gilead did not owe \$1B in royalties for patents held by CDC for HIV PrEP.

Eli Lilly <u>will acquire DICE Therapeutics</u> (\$2.4B)... Washington Health System <u>plans to integrate</u> into UPMC... Ochsner and MD Anderson <u>announced an oncology partnership</u>.

Commonwealth Fund reported preventable/premature deaths reached historic levels from 2019-2021 due to COVID-19, treatable chronic diseases, and record-high drug overdoses and alcohol-induced deaths... KFF estimated states received over \$117B in increased Medicaid FMAP during the pandemic's continuous coverage period, keeping state Medicaid spending below 2019 levels.

Humana and UnitedHealth are <u>considering Medicare Advantage (MA)</u> <u>benefit adjustments</u> due to changes in expense and reimbursement trends... A majority of <u>House members</u> and <u>Senators</u> urged CMS to finalize streamlined MA prior authorization policies.

The House passed <u>legislation (220-209) making it easier for employers to offer individual coverage health reimbursement arrangements</u>, which <u>CBO estimated</u> could increase the deficit by \$348M over 10 years.

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
