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Healthcare regulatory news

HHS/Labor/Treasury are <u>seeking comments on requiring health plan</u> <u>coverage</u> of <u>over-the-counter preventive items/services</u> without costsharing or a prescription.

FDA granted emergency use authorization for Novavax's updated COVID-19 vaccine... FDA approved the <u>first biosimilar for Actemra</u>... FDA <u>issued</u> <u>draft guidance</u> aiming to <u>spur development of stimulant use disorder</u> <u>treatments</u>... Reagan-Udall Foundation <u>provided recommendations for</u> <u>FDA</u> to improve public communication and combat misinformation.

SAMHSA <u>awarded nearly \$35M in grants</u> for behavioral health services and HIV prevention/care in underserved communities.

HHS <u>OIG estimated increased biosimilar use in 2021</u> could have decreased Medicare Part B and enrollee spending by \$179M (4%).



Healthcare law and policy news

The <u>continuing resolution</u> enacted last weekend <u>delays Medicaid DSH cuts</u> <u>and extends funding for several health programs</u>, including community health centers, through November 17.

A federal court <u>denied Chamber of Commerce's request for injunctive relief</u>, allowing <u>CMS to continue implementing</u> the Medicare Drug Price Negotiation Program... Manufacturers of <u>all 10 drugs selected for</u> <u>negotiation</u> agreed to participate in the process.

A <u>federal court struck down</u> an HHS rule allowing insurers <u>not to count drug</u> <u>manufacturer copay assistance toward patient out-of-pocket costs</u>... Cigna <u>will pay \$172M to settle False Claims Act violation</u> allegations related to Medicare Advantage (MA).

US PTO's Patent Trial and Appeal Board <u>will review</u> one of Novo Nordisk's patents for Ozempic and Wegovy <u>following a challenge from Mylan</u>; the Board <u>rejected two other Mylan challenges</u>.

Sutter Health <u>finalized its acquisition of Sansum Clinic</u>... Lilly <u>plans to</u> <u>acquire Point Biopharma</u> (\$1.4B)... Sanofi is <u>exploring acquiring Mirati</u> <u>Therapeutics</u>... Sanofi and Teva will <u>collaborate (up to \$1.5B) on</u> <u>development/commercialization</u> of an inflammatory bowel disease treatment... Viatris <u>divested \$3.6B in assets</u>, including <u>its over-the-counter</u> <u>business</u> (\$2.17B)... Rock Health <u>reported digital health investment in Q3</u> (\$2.5B across 119 deals) was the second lowest guarter since Q4 2019.

Boehringer Ingelheim <u>launched an unbranded version of its Humira</u> <u>biosimilar</u>, priced 81% cheaper than the original biologic... Alignment Health and Instacart plan to <u>launch co-branded MA plans</u> in 2024... Beginning next year, SCAN will <u>offer MA beneficiaries free or \$11 monthly</u> <u>co-pays</u> for 13 name-brand drugs, including six subject to Medicare price negotiation.

Kaufman Hall <u>reported hospital monthly operating margins</u> were up 2.9% in August and 1.1% year-to-date.

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
