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# Healthcare regulatory news

CMS announced the Direct Contracting Model generated \$371.5M in Medicare net savings in 2022, more than 5x savings in 2021 (\$70.4M).

HRSA <u>reversed a pandemic policy</u>, once again <u>requiring 340B hospitals to register offsite clinics</u> and list them on Medicare cost reports.

OMB is <u>reviewing</u> a <u>ONC final rule</u> on health IT interoperability and certification.

HHS and CISA released a Healthcare and Public Health Cybersecurity toolkit... HHS is reportedly considering requiring minimum cybersecurity standards for federal program payments.

FDA released <u>draft guidance</u> on drug manufacturer <u>communication of</u> <u>scientific information</u> to providers about off-label product uses... FDA <u>lifted</u> <u>a hold, allowing Verve Therapeutics to conduct</u> a US-based trial of its

gene-editing high cholesterol treatment... FDA is reviewing AstraZeneca's application for a patient/caregiver-administered nasal flu vaccine.

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## Healthcare law and policy news

Roche <u>will acquire Televant Holdings</u> (\$7.1B), including an experimental inflammatory bowel diseases therapy... UPMC and Washington Health System <u>signed</u> a <u>merger agreement</u>... Prospect Medical Holdings <u>will sell Crozer Health</u> as part of an agreement with the PA Attorney General... Blue Cross NC will <u>acquire all North Carolina-based FastMed</u> urgent care centers... Sanofi plans to spin off its consumer healthcare business.

Several independent <u>pharmacies sued Express Scripts for allegedly colluding</u> with Prime Therapeutics to fix reimbursement rates... Sanofi is <u>partnering with GoodRx to offer</u> its insulin <u>Lantus for \$35</u>, regardless of insurance status, at thousands of pharmacies... GNC <u>will offer new membership plans</u> with access to <u>virtual urgent and primary care</u>.

A <u>BMJ</u> study found oncologists are more likely to provide low-value care after receiving pharmaceutical industry payments... A Georgetown analysis <u>estimated 1.9M children have lost Medicaid</u> coverage since redeterminations... Urban Institute/RWJF <u>projected 2.3M individuals would gain coverage</u> if remaining states adopted ACA-funded Medicare expansion... Trilliant Health <u>data show</u> primary care visits fell 6.3% between 2021-2022; ED visits increased 3.1%... A <u>JAMA study found</u> all but 29.9% of Medicare Part D spending on 45 high-utilization generics in 2021 went to intermediary (PBM, pharmacy, wholesaler) gross profit.

Commonwealth Fund reported 51% of working-age adults, including 57% with individual or marketplace insurance coverage, have difficulty affording healthcare costs... A Carta Healthcare survey found 38% of Americans trust Al and 57% have a good understanding of Al's applications for healthcare.

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
