Healthcare regulatory news

CMS <u>announced</u> the <u>Transforming Maternal Health (TMaH) Model</u> to support up to 15 states in developing <u>whole-person pregnancy</u>, <u>childbirth and postpartum care</u> approaches, including expanded access to maternal health providers. HHS-Labor-Treasury <u>finalized</u> an amended <u>\$115 administrative fee</u> for the surprise billing independent resolution process; the <u>dispute</u> <u>resolution portal also reopened</u> for batched disputes.

Department of Labor <u>proposed rescinding</u> the 2018 association health plan (AHP) rule and reevaluating AHP criteria.

CMS <u>data show</u> 5 states accounted for 54.1% (1.2M of 2.2M) of all children disenrolled from Medicaid from March through September 2023, with highest disenrollment in non-expansion states... HHS Secretary Xavier Becerra <u>urged 9 states to adopt additional federal</u> <u>strategies</u> to prevent further disenrollments.

FDA released <u>draft guidance</u> on use of real-world data/evidence in medical device approval decisions... FDA <u>granted priority review</u> to Merck's experimental pneumococcal vaccine.

Healthcare law and policy news

Department of Justice (DOJ) and FTC <u>finalized</u> updated <u>Merger</u> <u>Guidelines</u>.

DOJ <u>asked a federal judge</u> to <u>transfer/dismiss a Humana lawsuit</u> challenging Medicare Advantage Risk Adjustment Data Validation (RADV) program changes.

Following an appeals court decision finding their merger anticompetitive, <u>Illumina plans to divest Grail</u>... Elevance Health and BCBS Louisiana <u>are reattempting a merger</u>, with the Blues plan seeking to reorganize as a for-profit... EQT Private Equity <u>plans to acquire</u> <u>Zeus</u>... Jefferson and Lehigh Valley Health Network <u>plan to merge</u>, creating a 30 hospital system... HCSC and Elevance are <u>reportedly</u> <u>exploring purchasing</u> Cigna's Medicare Advantage business... Community Health Network will pay \$345M to settle <u>False Claims Act</u> violations.

Driven by an <u>AI Executive Order</u> in October, 28 payers and providers <u>made voluntary commitments</u> on safety, security, and transparency of AI use in healthcare. A Washington Post investigation found <u>nearly 100 people have died</u> <u>after wandering away</u> or being left unattended outside of assistedliving and memory-care facilities since 2018.

A JAMA Health Forum analysis found facility fees for colonoscopies at hospitals were approximately 55% higher than those at ambulatory surgical centers in the same county with the same insurer... A Gallup survey found Americans' assessment of care provided in the US healthcare system has declined for nearly every healthcare entity since 2010; nurses remain the highest rated (82% of respondents rate their care as excellent/good).
