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Healthcare regulatory news

CMS <u>released an RFI</u> on <u>Medicare Advantage data collection/capabilities</u> to inform policymaking.

CMS <u>announced actions</u> to educate patients about rights to emergency medical care under EMTALA and support hospitals in meeting those obligations... HHS <u>reminded providers</u> that patients, regardless of insurance status, should not pay full out-of-pocket costs for COVID-19 antivirals, even as they transition to the commercial market.

An FDA official confirmed the agency's plan to overhaul its inspection processes for facilities producing drugs, medical devices, and food products by year-end... FDA is requiring several CAR-T cancer therapy manufacturers to add "boxed warnings" about potential risk of secondary T-cell malignancies... CMS and FDA released a joint statement supporting FDA's regulatory authority over laboratory developed tests.

ASPR <u>released</u> voluntary healthcare/public health sector <u>cybersecurity</u> performance goals and announced a cybersecurity resources portal.

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Healthcare law and policy news

CMS announced a record <u>21.3M individuals selected ACA marketplace</u> <u>plans</u> during 2024 open enrollment.

A district court <u>approved Gilead's \$247M settlement</u> to end allegations it forced direct purchasers to overpay for HIV treatment/prevention drugs... Three generic <u>drug manufacturers will pay \$45M</u> to <u>settle price fixing allegations</u>.

Sanofi <u>plans to acquire Inhibrx</u> (\$2.2B)... Sandoz <u>made its first acquisition</u> since spinoff from Novartis, gaining rights to a biosimilar of Lucentis from Coherus BioSciences (\$170M)... FTC <u>sued to block Novant's acquisition</u> of two CHS hospitals (\$320M).

Kaufman Hall reported hospital/health system deal volume increased from 2022 (53) to 2023 (65); financial distress was cited as a factor or otherwise evident in 28% of transactions, up from 15%.

Instacart <u>is partnering with DispatchHealth</u> to enable prescribing/delivery of food interventions to patients' homes... Amazon Pharmacy is <u>piloting medication consults</u> with One Medical providers... UnitedHealthcare <u>launched a resource hub</u> for employers to select wellness and other health programs/vendors.

Center for Healthcare Quality and Payment Reform reported 55% of US rural hospitals lack labor/delivery services, and offered recommendations to improve access... An Urban Institute/RWJF analysis found Black Medicaid patients are much more likely than white patients to be hospitalized for preventable conditions, including diabetes, lung diseases, and heart failure... Gibbins Advisors reported 2023 had the most healthcare sector bankruptcy in five years.

WHO <u>released recommendations</u> on governance/ethics of using large multi-modal AI models for health.

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
