CRS Reportable Jurisdictions

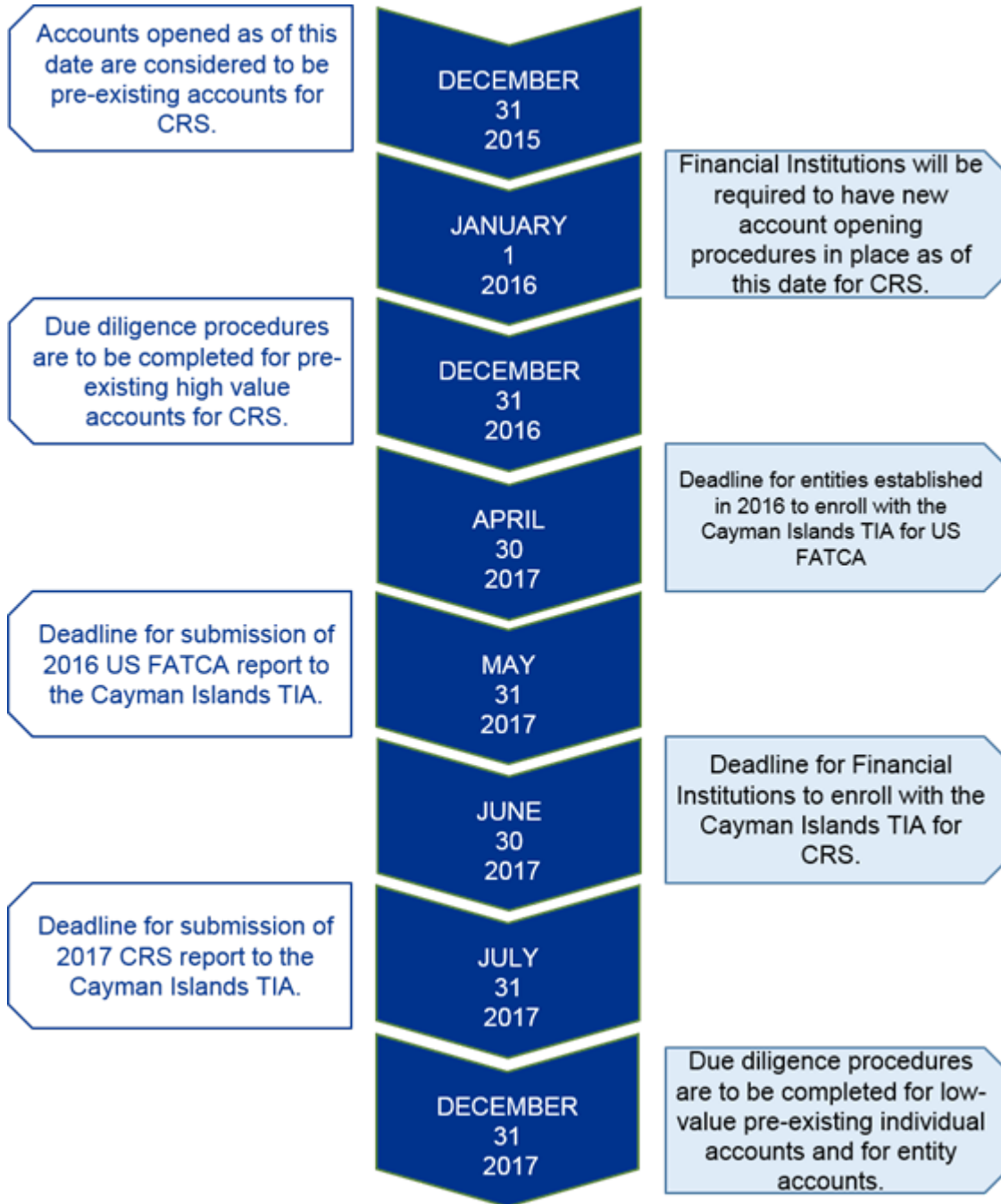
On Friday, March 31, 2017 the Cayman Islands Department for International Tax Cooperation has published lists in respect of Participating Jurisdictions and Reportable Jurisdictions for the purposes of the Tax information Authority (International Tax Compliance) (Common Reporting Standard) Regulations.

The lists are included in Extraordinary Gazette Supplement No.29/2017, dated Friday 31 March 2017, which is available [here](#).

KPMG Comments:

It is noted that the Reportable Jurisdictions list is largely similar to the list issued by other jurisdictions (e.g. Isle of Man, Guernsey) with some exceptions. For example, Jersey and Mauritius are notable countries which are not included on the list of reportable jurisdictions for the Cayman Islands.
