
Looks at the discreet effort, outcome-focused productivity, authorization to complete, and linkages to other tasks and humans

A client's journey

Coverage

Global Petro-Chemical business – ERP 'carve-out' project





Challenges

- Required to stand up new global ERP instance for 'carve-out' of business area
- Implementation was combined with introduction of a new toll-manufacturing supply chain model

Our approach

- Established clear governance to ensure Tax input for all key decisions
- Primary approach was to automate taxes (VAT, TP) within ERP
- Where specific local country requirements were identified that ERPcould not deliver (Brazil, India, Spain, China, Hungary etc, worked to deploy other specific tools to ensure compliance

Benefits

- Conducted worldwide ERP set-up deep-dive
- Applied KPMG's proven tax technology to automate processes and improve data quality, driving cost reduction and better data insights
- Devised and implemented a new operating model enabled by KPMG's leading tax technology teams

Data challenges

- The new supply chain model required additional data capture to ensure tax processes were robust (e.g. Transfer pricing)
- A global approach to data management and reporting with local requirement considerations
- Issues faced in previous technology implementation meant extra focus on tax data and requirements to ensure compliance

Collaboration Approach

- Original approach was to bring all teams together in 1-2 week long workshops, system testing cycles
- COVID-19 hit half-way through the project shutting whole offices down around the world.
- Client and KPMG scrambled to get a virtual ecosystem set up in which work could/did continue. This
 included:
- Use of collaboration software (e.g. Skype, Teams) for communication
- Use of collaboration sites for sharing data (e.g. SharePoint, client's legacy collaboration site)
- Virtual testing HUBs for UAT
- Use of KPMG's digital gateway offering for Workflow management related to testing, dress rehearsal, cutover and go-live




