

- Do the relevant employees attend regular VAT training?
- Have you performed a VAT health check or review recently?
- Are you comfortable that the declarations made in the VAT returns are accurate and complete?

- Do you have procedures in place to ensure that you are in possession of the prescribed supporting documentation relating to input tax claims?
- Are all external VAT advice and SARS VAT rulings relied on valid and in-line with the latest VAT legislation?
- Has SARS notified you of an impending VAT audit or requested information to be submitted relating to VAT that is not part of the monthly verification process?
