UPON THE APPLICATION of the Plaintiff, Royal Bank of Canada ("RBC") for a Consent Receivership Order; AND UPON having read the Affidavit of Marlene Starenky, sworn on January 9, 2020, the Affidavit of Robert Pound, sworn on January 31, 2020, the Affidavit of Edwin Pound, sworn on January 31, 2020 and the Affidavit of Ryan Murphy, sworn on January 31, 2020; AND UPON having heard the submissions of counsel for RBC and counsel for the Defendants, McArthur Furniture (Alberta) Ltd., MTK Properties Ltd., Theresa Pound and Edwin Pound:

IT IS HEREBY ORDERED AS FOLLOWS:

- 1. The Application of RBC for a Consent Receivership Order is hereby granted (the "Receivership Order"),
- 2. The Receivership Order is hereby stayed until 12:00pm (noon) on Friday, February 14. 2020.
- 3. If, prior to 12:00pm (noon) on Friday, February 14, 2020, the Defendants provide written confirmation to counsel for RBC that all of the outstanding conditions to the sale of McArthur Calgary (as defined in the Affidavit of Robert Pound) have been walved and/or

satisfied, such confirmation to include all supporting documentation, the stay of the Receivership Order shall continue and be extended until 12:00pm (noon) on Tuesday, March 31, 2020.

- 4. If, prior to 12:00pm (noon) on Tuesday, March 31, 2020, the Defendants provide written confirmation to counsel for RBC that the sale of McArthur Calgary and the sale of McArthur Airdrie (as defined in the Affidavit of Robert Pound) have closed, such confirmation to include all supporting documentation, the stay of the Receivership Order shall continue and be extended until further Order of this Honourable Court.
- 5. As a condition of this Order and in consideration of the stays contemplated herein, the Defendants have consented to waive any and all appeal rights that they may have in relation to the granting of this Order and the Receivership Order.
- 6. The parties hereto may mutually agree to extend or otherwise modify the dates set forth in paragraphs 2 and 3 herein.
