#### ORDER

**THIS MOTION**, brought by KPMG Inc., the liquidator (the "Liquidator") of the insurance business of Reliance Insurance Company in Canada ("Reliance Canada"), was heard this day at 330 University Avenue, Toronto, Ontario.

**ON READING** the Report of the Liquidator dated February 24, 2012, filed, and upon hearing the submissions of counsel for the Liquidator,

- 1. **THIS COURT ORDERS** that the service made of the Notice of Motion and supporting materials herein is good and sufficient notice of this motion, that this motion is properly returnable today and that any further service of the Notice of Motion and supporting materials be and the same is hereby dispensed with.
- 2. THIS COURT ORDERS that the Liquidator is hereby authorized to deliver to holders of policies with Reliance Canada (the "Policyholders") having loss claims under insurance policies issued by Reliance Canada (the "Policy Loss Claims"), which are disputed by the Liquidator (the "Disputed Claims"), a notice of disallowance, substantially in the form attached hereto as Schedule "A" (the "Notice of Disallowance") by prepaid ordinary mail, courier, personal delivery, facsimile or electronic mail to the address, facsimile number or e-mail address for Policyholders as may be recorded in the books and records of Reliance Canada, as set out in the Policyholder's proof of claim filed with the Liquidator, or to such other address, facsimile number or e-mail address as such Policyholder may request by notice in writing to the Liquidator.
- 3. **THIS COURT ORDERS** that any Policyholder wishing to appeal a Notice of Disallowance shall deliver to the Liquidator a notice of appeal, substantially in the form attached hereto as Schedule "B" (the "Notice of Appeal"), within sixty (60) days from the date of the Notice of Disallowance by prepaid ordinary mail, courier, personal delivery or facsimile to the address or fax number for the Liquidator as set out in the Notice of Appeal.

4. **THIS COURT ORDERS** that, upon receipt of a Notice of Appeal, the Liquidator may attempt to consensually resolve the amount of the Disputed Claim with the Policyholder.

5. THIS COURT ORDERS that if a Policyholder does not deliver a Notice of Appeal in accordance with the provisions of and timeframes provided by paragraph 3 above, then the Notice of Disallowance shall be deemed to be accepted as final and binding on the Policyholder, and the Policyholder shall be and is hereby forever barred from making or enforcing the Policy Loss Claim to the extent that it exceeds the amount, if any, accepted in the Notice of Disallowance (the "Excess Policy Loss Claim") and the Excess Policy Loss Claim shall be forever extinguished, barred and released, and the Policyholder shall be deemed to have fully and finally released and discharged the Excess Policy Loss Claim.
