3. The phrase "Energybuild Ltd." in paragraph 3 of the Order of this Court dated December 13, 2017 is hereby deleted in its entirety and replaced with ""Energybuild Holdings Limited", which shall be effective *nunc pro tunc* as of the date of such Order.

STAY EXTENSION

5. The Stay Period, as defined in paragraph 18 of the Initial Order, is hereby further extended up to and including April 16, 2018.

GENERAL

6. Endorsement of this Order by counsel appearing, other than counsel for the Monitor, is hereby dispensed with.

All courts, tribunals, regulatory and administrative bodies are hereby respectfully requested to make such orders and to provide such assistance to the Petitioners and to the Monitor, as an officer of this Court, as may be necessary or desirable to give effect to this Order, to grant representative status to the Monitor in any foreign proceeding, or to assist the Petitioners and the Monitor and their respective agents in carrying out the terms of this Order.
