#### **AFFIDAVIT**

I, **WILLIAM E. AZIZ**, Chief Restructuring Officer, of the Town of Oakville, in the Province of Ontario, MAKE OATH AND SAY AS FOLLOWS:

- 1. I am the President of BlueTree Advisors Inc. ("BlueTree") which has been retained to provide my services as Chief Restructuring Officer ("CRO") to the Petitioners (the "New Walter Canada Group"). As such I have personal knowledge of the facts hereinafter deposed, except where such facts are stated to be based upon information and belief, and where so stated I do verily believe the same to be true.
- This Affidavit is made in support of a motion by the New Walter Canada Group under the Companies' Creditors Arrangement Act, R.S.C. 1985, c. C-36 (the "CCAA") seeking an Order under the CCAA extending the stay of proceedings in respect of the New Walter Canada Group to May 31, 2017.

- I was initially retained by Walter Energy Canada Holdings, Inc. ("Walter Energy Canada") to provide my services as CRO to Walter Energy Canada, its direct and indirect subsidiaries and affiliates, and the partnerships listed on Schedule "C" to the Order of this Honourable Court made on December 7, 2015 (the "Initial Order") (such corporations and partnerships, excluding Cambrian Energybuild Holdings ULC, collectively are the "Old Walter Canada Group"). I was retained pursuant to an engagement letter dated December 30, 2015 (the "BlueTree Engagement Letter") as amended in response to certain requests made by Old Walter Canada Group stakeholders. BlueTree was appointed as CRO of the Old Walter Canada Group pursuant to paragraph 9 of the Order of this Honourable Court made on January 5, 2016 (the "SISP Order").
- 4. My engagement as CRO of the Old Walter Canada Group was terminated on December 15, 2016, when the entities comprising that group filed for bankruptcy.
- 5. Pursuant to the authorization granted in paragraph 5 of the Order of this Honourable Court made on December 7, 2016 (the "CCAA Procedure Order"), the entities comprising the New Walter Canada Group were incorporated on December 8, 2016. Each entity became a Petitioner in these CCAA Proceedings and subject to the CCAA Charges (as defined in the CCAA Procedure Order), and I became CRO of the New Walter Canada Group when the entities comprising that group were formed.
- 6. The information in this affidavit is arranged under the following headings:

- I. COMPLETION OF THE RESIDUAL ASSET SALE TRANSACTION
- As described in my fifth affidavit sworn on December 2, 2016 in these proceedings (the "Fifth Aziz Affidavit"), Walter Energy Canada, for and on behalf of the Old Walter Canada Group, as subject, agreed to a transaction (the "Residual Asset Sale Transaction") contemplated by a term sheet dated November 28, 2016 (the "Term Sheet"). The Term Sheet was approved by this Honourable Court in the CCAA Procedure Order. An amendment to the steps to the Transaction set out in the Term Sheet was approved by an Order of this Honourable Court made on December 12, 2016.
- 8. To implement the Residual Asset Sale Transaction, the members of the Old Walter Canada Group made a voluntary assignment into bankruptcy and then made a joint proposal (the "**Proposal**") under the *Bankruptcy and Insolvency Act*, R.S.C. 1985, c. B-3. The Proposal was approved at a meeting of the creditors of the Old Walter Canada Group on December 19, 2016, and sanctioned by an order of this Honourable Court (in bankruptcy and insolvency) made on December 21, 2016.

- 9. The Proposal Commencement date (as defined in the Proposal) occurred on December 28, 2016, after the delivery and filing of the Trustee's Certificate and the Monitor's Certificate, attached hereto as Exhibits "A" and "B".
- 10. The Proposal was completed on December 29, 2016, when the Office of the Superintendent of Bankruptcy recorded the Proposal's completion in its records. A copy of the results of an electronic search of the Office of the Superintendent of Bankruptcy's records, dated December 30, 2016, is attached hereto as **Exhibit "C"**.

# II. STAY EXTENSION

- 11. This Honourable Court granted a stay of proceedings in the Initial Order, until January 6, 2016, or such later date as this Honourable Court may order (the "Stay Period"). On January 5, 2016, this Honourable Court extended the Stay Period until and including April 5, 2016. On March 30, 2016, this Honourable Court extended the Stay Period until and including June 24, 2016. On June 24, 2016, this Honourable Court extended the Stay Period until and including August 19, 2016. On August 16, 2016, this Honourable Court extended the Stay Period until and including January 17, 2017.
- 12. The New Walter Canada Group is requesting an extension of the Stay Period until and including May 31, 2017. This extension is being requested to allow the New Walter Canada Group to continue the claims process established by the order of the Court made on August 16, 2016 (the "Claims Process Order"), including adjudication of the 1974 Pension Plan Claim, and to address matters relating to the Walter U.K. Group (as defined in the SISP Order).
- 13. From my review of the current cash flow projections, I do verily believe that the New Walter Canada Group will have sufficient operating cash to continue operations during the proposed extended Stay Period.
- 14. The New Walter Canada Group has been proceeding in good faith and with due diligence in these proceedings. In addition to the activities described in my fifth affidavit sworn on December 2, 2016, in these proceedings, the New Walter Canada Group has been working to complete the Residual Asset Sale Transaction and to address claims process matters, including the 1974 Plan Claim.
- 15. It is my understanding that the Monitor supports the extension of the Stay Period and will file a report attaching a cash flow forecast that demonstrates, subject to the assumptions more fully set out in the report, that the New Walter Canada Group has sufficient liquidity to continue its operations as currently conducted through to the end of the proposed extended Stay Period.

16. It is in the best interests of the New Walter Canada Group and all its stakeholders that the Stay Period be extended to May 31, 2017 to enable the New Walter Canada Group to complete the claims process and deal with matters relating to the Walter U.K. Group.

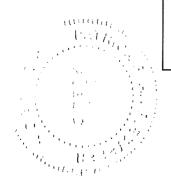

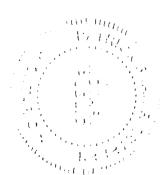
